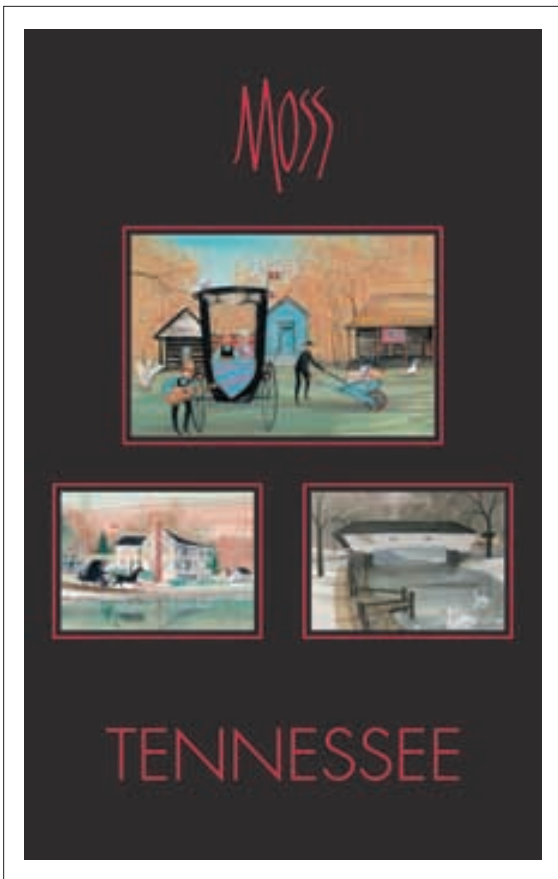

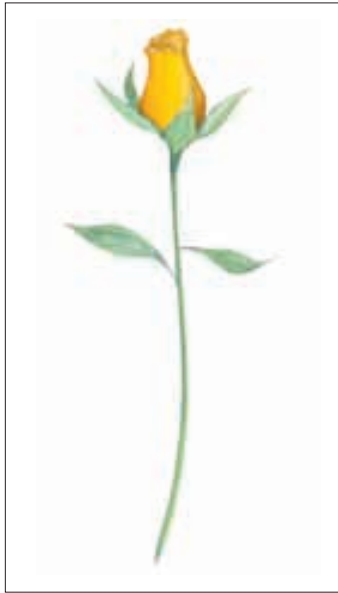

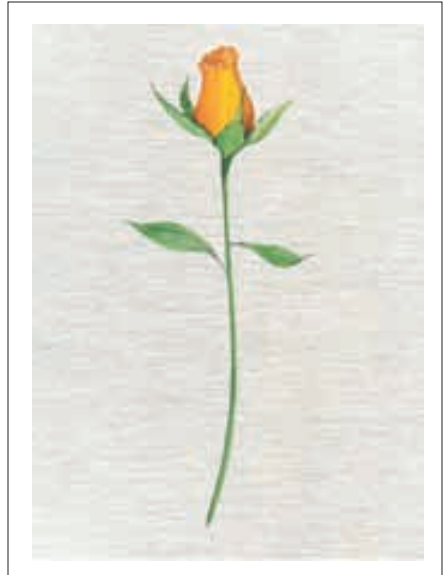

Buffalo Mountain Heritage depicts the Mayberry Presbyterian Church located in Patrick County, Virginia. It is one of five historic rock churches located on the Blue Ridge Parkway. Buffalo Mountain is in the background.

Carlisle Barracks giclée, located in Carlisle, Pennsylvania, has been at the forefront of pioneering military education for more than 200 years. The US Army War College is located on Carlisle Barracks.

Phipps Conservatory depicts Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens, a great steel and glass Victorian greenhouse, which has been inviting visitors to explore the beauty and mysteries of plants since 1893 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Summer at Longwood features Longwood, the home built by Thomas Henry Cooper in 1904. It was a landmark attraction in Salem, Virginia until it burned in 1968.

Tennessee Heritage is a depiction of historic Exchange Place in Kingsport, Tennessee, which functioned as a family farm in the mid-1800's.

The *Tennessee Heritage* poster features historic Exchange Place, Netherland Inn, and the Doe River Bridge.

All pieces, except the giclées, are offset lithographs reproduced from watercolors in one time editions of 500 and 25 artist's proofs, except *Amoré* which is a one time edition of 1,500 and 25 artists proofs. *Carlisle Barracks* is a one time edition of 750 and 25 artist's proofs and the *Amoré giclée* on metal plate is a one time edition of 250 plates total.
